

Call Change Competition Rules.

- 1 Each team should consist of regular and frequent Sunday ringers attached to the tower being represented. A maximum of two others may ring with a band as long as they regularly and frequently assist at practices. A tower may enter two bands providing they are drawn from a minimum of ten competing ringers.
- 2 For entry in the novice competition, a team should include at least 3 ringers who have been ringing for 3 years or less.
- 3 The test piece will consist of 6 minutes of rounds and call changes. No faults will be counted in the first minute of ringing. The call changes should include Queens, Tittums and Reverse Rounds. Towers that normally ring on 5 bells are allowed to ring on 5 if they wish.
- 4 A preliminary period of two minutes ringing is allowed for teams to adjust the ropes and get used to the bells. This is not judged.
- 5 The team shall let the judge know that they are ready to start by giving two full pulls on the treble.
- 6 The team with the least faults shall be entrusted with the safekeeping of the Harry Butler Memorial Cup, to be held for one year. The novice team with the least faults shall be entrusted with the safekeeping of the Call Change Trophy to be held for one year.
- 7 The decision of the judge(s) is final.
