

Wisborough Green Church – Circular Church Walk

Overview

Circular walk of just over 5 miles on level ground which should take about 1 hour 50 minutes at normal walking pace without stops.

The anticlockwise route heads south from the Church to Harsfold Manor then turns East/North following the Wey & Arun Canal up to Paplands Farm before turning West past Fishers Farm and back to Wisborough Green.

Notes to accompany map

1. From Church/Village Hall car park drop down to the A272 and head East towards Billingshurst. Take the tarmac road South almost opposite Glebe Way towards Harsfold Manor
2. After the tarmac road runs out follow farm track straight on through metal gate and over bridge to canal
3. Just before next bridge turn left and follow Wey South Path Northwards
4. Continue to follow Wey South Path over Flood Gate Bridge, past a disused lock. The track leaves the canal side for a short while across some open grass, over a stile and a small wooden bridge
5. Keep going until you reach the A272
6. Cross A272 and continue straight ahead on the Wey South Path – look out for kingfishers on this stretch near Northlands Lift Bridge
7. After a short while you will see giant electricity pylons in the distance – just before you reach them, take the path to the left over a brick bridge and across grassland towards Paplands Farm and the exit gate in the right hand corner
8. Follow the track to the road and continue straight ahead until you join the B2133
9. Go straight over the B2133 past the Bat & Ball pub and simply follow this road back to Wisborough Green
