### **CROYDON TRAMLINE OUTING!**

Towers have been arranged for those using the train. Train leaves West Worthing at 09.01 and stops at East Croydon. Change train too South Croydon – arrives there at 10.31. Church should be visible from exiting the station and is approx. a five minute walk.

**Toilets are available at station – there are none at first church!**

**(For those driving – ample space in station car park for £5.10 – payment by smart app only – no cash or credit card facility!!!!)**

**10.40 – 11.30 St Peter's Church, South Croydon. CR0 1EZ 12, 30.0.20**

Head back to East Croydon Station – train at 11.50 arrives 11.53 *or*

Bus no: 433 at 11.40 or 11.50 – 6 minute trip. *or*

Walk – 1.9 kilometres (timings accommodate this!)

At East Croydon, use tram stop outside station and head for Wimbledon and alight at the Merton Park tram stop,. Church not easy to spot in distance as tower is low. Should take @ 10 minutes to walk there.

**12.30 – 1.10 St Mary's Merton Park. SW19 3HJ. 6, 7.0.26**

### **LUNCH!!! (OWN ARRANGEMENTS)**

**If having a picnic – there is Wandle Park near the next Tower so may be worth making your way there!**



To get to next Tower - walk to Kingston Road and catch 152 bus and ask for Collier's Wood tube station. *or*

Walk - distance 2.4 kilometres - @ 30 minutes.

**2.30 – 3.10 - Christ Church, Colliers Wood, SW19 2NY. 6, 6.0.19**

To get to next Tower - need to get back to Merton. We will have passed Merton Church on way to Merton Park to Collier's Wood.

Catch tube from Collier's Wood towards South Wimbledon – Merton is one stop from Collier's Wood. *Or*

Walk (less than 30 minutes) *or*

Catch the 152 Bus.

**3.40 - 4.30 - St. John the Divine. 10, 11.3.27.**

Easiest way to get back to East Croydon and the train home is to take the @ 10 minute (0.6 kilometre) walk from the church along the Morden Road to the Morden Road Tram stop. The tram will stop outside the front entrance of East Croydon Station!
