

Visiting All Saints Church, Lindfield

The Church has a car park open to visitors which forms part of a larger public car park.

For Sat Nav use post code RH16 2JB but check that the route ends along a road called “The Wilderness”.

Approaching from the North

When approaching Lindfield from the north on the B2028, you will drive past All Saints Church on your left then take first left into Brushes Lane, passing beside The Bent Arms on the corner, followed by another left into The Wilderness. Continue around to the left into the car park. Parking for the church is at the far end and is clearly marked. Parking in the public section of the car park is limited to 2 hours.

Approaching from the South

When approaching Lindfield from the south on the B2028, you will see The Bent Arms on your right-hand side and you need to turn right beside that into Brushes Lane followed by a left turn into The Wilderness. Continue around to the left into the car park. Parking for the church is at the far end and is clearly marked. Parking in the public section of the car park is limited to 2 hours.

From Car Park to the Ringing Chamber

There are 2 routes from the car park to the church. Either exit the car park in the far north-west corner and follow the pathway to the left going underneath an archway onto the High Street and turn right to take the pavement and then church path to the church porch.

Alternatively, exit the car park again from the far north-west but this time take the right-hand path passing a small double garage and church yard wall on your left. Turn left onto another church path to the church porch.

Once at the porch, go through the glass doors into the church itself. The ringing chamber is above ground level on your left.
